THE COMMUNITY GIVES BACK – HOW YOUR DONATIONS HELP AT HOPE

In 2009 your donations...

- helped serve 46,904 people; including children and families (12,222 households)
- helped provide 780 Emergency Food Packages (value \$78,000.00)
- helped by providing in-kind donations such as...
 - clothing
 - shoes
 - school supplies
 - bedding/bath supplies
 - household goods
 - furniture
 - sporting goods
 - appliances
 - computers, printers and more (totaling \$105,624.00)

- Your financial donations provided families with over **\$15,111.58** in financial assistance being provided for those in crisis, including:
 - Housing assistance; Mortgage, rental, and motels
 - Financial emergency assistance
 - store purchase cards / grocery cards
 - Utilities; electric, water
 - vehicle Repairs, gas and bus passes
 - educational supplies



Thanksgiving 2009

- This year HOPE partnered with the First United Methodist church who helped supply turkeys, side dishes for a Thanksgiving Feast. Total value donated by HOPE - \$1,000.00

Christmas 2009 (in partnership with our OneBody of Churches at the Christmas in the City)

- Over 531 Families received complete Christmas dinners - Totaling \$26,500.00
- 1,060 children/teens received 1 present/gift card (value avg. \$20 per gift) total of \$21,200.00
- Clothing given to 1,060 children/teens (inc. jeans, socks, underwear and shoes) - \$25,500.00
- Hot meal served to 1,400 people at event (cost \$1.81) per person - \$2,534.00
- Total donations at CITC - \$75,734.00

Volunteer hours at thrift store, food pantry, outreach events- total value of **\$410,114.90**

Total in-kind donations given to families in 2009.... \$2,912,753.00
